The case was ultimately held for 2 weeks. Tolbert (abutting property owner) was there in opposition. At this point, the opposition is such that the super majority vote is triggered. CC Fantroy asked the City Attorney if you were the same Bill

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Fisher that he has a contract with b/c if so he would need to excuse himself. The planning director stated that you are the same Bill Fisher and that it was best that CC Fantroy excuse himself. The motion was made by CC Thornton-Reese to close the public hearing and hold the case for two weeks. The Mayor said that the public hearing could not be closed if the case was being held. The final motion was to keep the public hearing open and to hold the case for 2 weeks.

Tolbert gave me a copy of his presentation which I have attached for you. He told me he might not oppose the case if they could get the information that they requested. And, he said that if the case passes his HOA will litigate.

There is meeting scheduled with CC Hill on Monday 2/14 at 4:00 o'clock at City Hall so we can go over the details of the project. It is imperative that you attend this meeting.

And, City Staff, the planner for the case, just called to ask me if this was a Tax Credit case. I told them to the best of my knowledge it was not currently pending for Tax Credit consideration. And, he wanted more information on who Bill Fisher was. He wanted to know if you were the same Bill Fisher that was formerly with Provident. He said that if he needed some additional information he would let me know.

And, last but not least, the firm has given me until the end of the week to bring your accounts current. You are over 84 days late on the invoices for this matter and over 121 days on the Camp Wisdom invoices. I have no more excuses that can use. I pass on you verbal assurances that these invoices will be handled timely and when they are not it makes everyone look bad.

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
