2 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmmm..
3 HILL: And then we'll have the meeting today at 4:30.
4 That'll, that'll get us a little, that'll get us
5 a little bit more attention on that meeting. Uh, and
6 uh, and then we've got the debate tonight so, hey, I
7 think that's good, that's good. I think, I think we
8 will be able to kind of have a good news day today.
9 FARRINGTON: I think that uh, I need to get that
10 camera early.
11 HILL: Yeah, yeah. I'm going to go by the office.
12 What time? You got a lunch to deal with BRIAN
13 today, don't you?
14 FARRINGTON: Yeah, at one.
15 HILL: Uh, so I'm gonna be down towards City Hall
16 around noontime today just for a little bit.
17 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm. Are you telling me that
18 cause you want me to come? Hmm? Hmm?
19 HILL: No, I told you that cause I want you to ask
20 BRIAN for two-thousand dollars of him and CHERYL
21 today.
22 FARRINGTON: Oh, okay.
23 HILL: Laughs
24 FARRINGTON: Laughs Okay. Silly me.
25

1 HILL: Oh, my goodness. Well, you're going to lunch,
2 UI, I mean, are you go to lunch with BRIAN or are you
3 meeting BRIAN?
4 FARRINGTON: Well, he suggested lunch so.
5 HILL: Okay, so I don't need you eating twice, shoot.
6 FARRINGTON: Well, I don't have to. You, you not
7 going to City Hall to eat.
8 HILL: Yeah, I'm just going to go by there just for a
9 minute and then I'm going on, I got to get me
10 something to eat. You know, I kind of run on fuel
11 too. You know what I mean? But, but I'm, I'm, I'm
12 saying that I'll be there at noon so you can come
13 through there and uh get the camera around that time.
14 Some, some things we got to kind of compare notes on
15 to kind of begin to put into play. We got, we got,
16 how many opponents do I have? I have one, two, three,
17 four opponents.
18 FARRINGTON: You do?
19 HILL: Four. So, you know, we just kind...
20 FARRINGTON: Wait a minute. How do, you know that
21 for sure?
22 HILL: Yeah.
23 FARRINGTON: Are they all filed.
24 HILL: Yeah.

1 FARRINGTON: You know it all ready?
2 HILL: Yeah.
3 FARRINGTON: Who is it? BETTY CULBREATH?
4 HILL: No, no, no. BETTY CULBREATH didn't file.
5 FARRINGTON: Okay.
6 HILL: You got JESSE DIAZ, you got uh, uh JURLINE
7 HOLLINS. Uh, then you got...
8 FARRINGTON: JURLINE HOLLINS?
9 HILL: Yes.
10 FARRINGTON: Is that your lady that's with uh,
11 housing or something?
12 HILL: No, it's a lady that comes down there every
13 time and complains about (UI). Her and HOPKINS kind
14 of run together.
15 FARRINGTON: HOPKINS, HOPKINS, HOPKINS. Oh.
16 HILL: WILLIAM HOPKINS.
17 FARRINGTON: The crazy HOPKINS?
18 HILL: Yeah, they kind of, they kind of play off one
19 another. They come down there and talk about taking
20 the money from the taxes and all that other kind of
21 stuff, you know.
22 FARRINGTON: Okay, so you got. You got uh, you got
23 JESSE DIAZ, you got HOPKINS. You got...
24 HILL: Not HOPKINS, JURLINE HOLLINS.
25

1 FARRINGTON: Okay. Laughs
2 HILL: What you laughing?
3 FARRINGTON: JURLINE HOLLINS and uh YOLANDA
4 WILLIAMS.
5 HILL: And then I got some lady named CAMILE WHITE
6 I don't know who CAMILE WHITE is. But,
7 I got a lady named CAMILE WHITE.
8 FARRINGTON: Oh, I've heard that name before.
9 HILL: We'll you going to know. Well, I don't know
10 whether you'll know about CAMILE WHITE or not, you
11 know.
12 FARRINGTON: Hmm. But ole ROBINSON jumped,
13 dropped out of the race period, huh?
14 HILL: I don't know what happened to ROBINSON, man.
15 FARRINGTON: I mean he was in the parade with his
16 little posterboard and everything. Laughs
17 HILL: Well LEO, LEO said, LEO CHANEY said that uh
18 the SOUTHWESTERN BELL people talked to him.
19 FARRINGTON: Hmm.
20 HILL: And I don't know whether that is true or not,
21 but who knows, you know.
22 FARRINGTON: The SOUTHWESTERN BELL people
23 didn't talk to all the rest of these people, huh?
24 Laughs

1 HILL: Laughs Well, I'll, in reality, he works for
2 SOUTHWESTERN BELL.
3 FARRINGTON: Oh, he does?
4 HILL: Yeah.
5 FARRINGTON: Okay.
6 HILL: So, they got a little more influence with him,
7 I guess.
8 FARRINGTON: Hmm.
9 HILL: Hey man, the reality is I need some, I need
10 some opponents to be able to raise money.
11 That's just reality.
12 FARRINGTON: Yeah, yeah, yeah.
13 Now you got four so...
14 HILL: I've got to raise money.
15 FARRINGTON: Or five.
16 HILL: That's right so I got to raise money. In
17 fact, BRIAN can give me three-thousand dollars and
18 give me uh, give me uh, give me uh, one for JACK too,
19 see what you can get?
20 FARRINGTON: Okay.
21 HILL: And if you have to go back and pick it up or
22 whatever you gotta do, let's see if we can get that
23 out of. And if BRIAN needs me to call him personally,
24 which I hope he don't.
25

1 FARRINGTON: I, I don't think he will. I don't think
2 he will.

3 HILL: Hold it a second. (Noise in background) So,
4 we off, we off, we off operating today. We
5 campaigning. We campaigning today, Miss, Miss, Miss
6 FARRINGTON.

7 FARRINGTON: Don't, don't be calling me Miss
8 FARRINGTON when you talkin' to me one on one. Like
9 you got an audience. Like you disconnected from me.

10 HILL: Sometime if I want to call you Miss
11 FARRINGTON, I am. Now you just going to have to just
12 deal with it. Sometime I might...

13 FARRINGTON: I'm just, I'm just going to have to deal
14 with it, huh?

15 HILL: That's right. Sometime I'm gonna want to, I
16 might want to have fun and I'm going to want to call
17 you Miss FARRINGTON. That's just the way it is.

18 FARRINGTON: Hmm hmm.

19 (Long silence)

20 UNKNOWN FEMALE (UF): Hi, how are you? Good
21 morning. I'm doing fine. How are you doing?

22 UF: Doing good.

23 HILL: I am too, good. Would you be kind enough to
24 send me two deposit slips, please.

25

1 UF: Of course.

2 HILL: Thank you.

3 FARRINGTON: Well, folks just talk to you any kind of
4 way, when they got you whipped. They just figure they
5 can do anything with you.

6 HILL: Yeah, I know. A Negro man is a terrible
7 thing.

8 FARRINGTON: It really is. That's the creation I
9 don't understand yet but okay. Just treats you any
10 old kind of way.

11 HILL: What's wrong..

12 FARRINGTON: You just got to deal with it.

13 HILL: What's wrong with these old hard head men?
14 Hard head men. Well, but you know what the good thing
15 about it is you're much loved baby. You're much
16 loved. You got a lot of love going on for you baby.
17 Lot a love. You got much love going on for you.

18 FARRINGTON: You mean from all these Negro men,
19 or, you?

20 HILL: What you say?

21 FARRINGTON: You mean from all these Negro men,
22 or, you?

23 HILL: Oh, I don't know nothing about no Negro men
24 and I don't know whether they love you or not. In
25

1 fact, I don't think, I don't, I don't any of them love
2 you. I just think they all lusting. That's the
3 difference between love and lust.

4 FARRINGTON: So, then you, you talking about
5 yourself then?

6 HILL: Well, I'm way past that.

7 FARRINGTON: What? No I said. Are you talking about
8 yourself with this much love stuff?

9 HILL: Oh yeah. I have love for you baby.

10 FARRINGTON: Oh, I bet you, bet you made sure you had
11 a double pane window up when you said that.

12 HILL: A double pane window. What was that about?

13 FARRINGTON: Make sure nobody in the world
14 hears that.

15 HILL: What you tell me?

16 FARRINGTON: Huh?

17 HILL: What you talking about? Huh?

18 FARRINGTON: (UI)

19 HILL: And, and make sure when BRIAN, when BRIAN
20 does, if BRIAN does that, it's, it's made out to the
21 campaign. Not office holder.

22 FARRINGTON: Okay. I wouldn't put office holder
23 any way.

24 HILL: Huh?

25

1 FARRINGTON: I wouldn't even think office holder.
2 HILL: Okay.
3 FARRINGTON: I would think campaign funds.
4 HILL: Did you and D'ANGELO work out that ten-
5 thousand dollars yesterday?
6 FARRINGTON: Yeah, we did fine with it. I told
7 him, you know. I didn't tell you him said it. I just
8 told him what you said. He agrees.
9 HILL: No need bringing you up on the radar screen
10 like that.
11 FARRINGTON: His, his car went out. Well, it didn't
12 go out. He had some kind of problem with it over the
13 weekend. It was running hot cause he put the wrong
14 coolant in. And so, he went and took it to the shop
15 and had it...
16 HILL: So, he had to put it in a shop?
17 FARRINGTON: Yeah, and we, yesterday it was for a
18 little split second without transportation.
19 HILL: Oh he needs, he may need to get him another
20 car, man. That car kind of, he's been having some
21 problems
22 with that car.
23 FARRINGTON: Well that's what he, that's what he,
24 that's why he was talking about that cause he knows
25

1 he, he owes like nine-thousand out on it and so he uh.
2 But I, I told him what you said. I didn't tell him
3 you, you know, you said it. I, you know. Cause he
4 did ask me about me about it. He asked me if I talked
5 to you about it.

6 HILL: Did he?

7 FARRINGTON: He's okay, he's cool with it.

8 HILL: I, I, I, you know what I, I, I love the
9 brother. I just I, I, I, I hope he doesn't feel like
10 he can't talk to me though.

11 FARRINGTON: No, he does. I mean, he knows he can
12 talk to you. He knows he can talk to you. Yeah, he
13 knows that. (Noise in background) He just feels
14 comfortable for whatever reason, I know it's crazy.

15 HILL: Oh, he likes talking to you cause he can talk
16 direct. Y'all, y'all real people. So, he likes
17 talking to you.

18 FARRINGTON: And he talks to me about everything.

19 HILL: Oh, I miss, I miss something. Oh, I'm sorry I
20 missed it. I apologize. I, I, I'm a send you a check
21 cause I left a check out and, and I, and when I was
22 giving that cash I gave you for one of them, I gave
23 you a hundred and fifty dollar deposit but I gave you

24

1 two hundred dollars so my expectation is to get fifty
2 back.

3 UF: Okay, no problem.

4 HILL: All right. I know you can figure all that out
5 but I wanted to make sure I had it together.

6 UF: No problem. I'm with you.

7 HILL: All right.

8 UF: Just a second (UI).

9 HILL: Okay, thank you. Yes ma'am Miss FARRINGTON.
10 My, my baby, that's my baby. My baby. Talk to me
11 baby. We're going to get out and raise some money,
12 man, and then we going, we going and pay FARRINGTON
13 AND ASSOCIATES some campaign money after we raise
14 some.

15 I think what we probably need to do SHEILA DENISE, we
16 run a campaign out of, out of uh, BURT BARR AND
17 ASSOCIATES. We got five, seven, eight telephone lines
18 so if we want to do calling we can. We can do
19 automatic calling. Uh, we need to put, probably need
20 to put together a brochure or two.

21 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm.

22 HILL: Uh, I think, I think what I'm going to do too
23 is I think I'm going to schedule to talk about charter
24 changes.

25

1 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm.

2 HILL: And (UI) between now and April 13th. I think
3 I'm going to schedule about two or three town hall
4 meetings in different parts of town.

5 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm.

6 HILL: Get it over there near Atwell. One over in uh
7 the middle area around Cummings and then another one
8 over there at Janie C. Turner or, or Pleasant Oaks.

9 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm. Okay. Okay. D'ANGELO also,
10 as you thought he would, talked to me about that...

11 HILL: That what?

12 FARRINGTON: The property.

13 HILL: Oh yeah, what he think? What'd you think?

14 FARRINGTON: Well, he says it's a duplex.

15 HILL: Oh, it's a duplex. Well, when he talked to me
16 about it was single family but now it's a duplex.
17 Well, hey you know, what it's worth, you know.

18 FARRINGTON: I know, he, he changes his mind
19 something about, just like yesterday. He says, how
20 long will you take. He says, I want to take S [REDACTED]
21 clothes shopping. I want to take her shopping. And I
22 said, why do you want, because I, because I want too.
23 I want to take her shopping, clothes shopping. And I
24 thought, ooh, let's see how long he, let's see how he
25

1 says he want to do that before he changes. Laughs
2 HILL: He, you know what the brother has a wonderful
3 heart but he...
4 FARRINGTON: He does, he got a real giving heart. He
5 does but...
6 HILL: He does, man. He's a...
7 FARRINGTON: He does. But then he wants to do so
8 much but then when it comes down to actually doing it.
9 Laughs
10 HILL: And I think sometimes he does want to, but he
11 recognizes how much money he got, how much
12 resources. You know, so I just think. You know, he's
13 just a really unusual guy.
14 FARRINGTON: Well, he just goes through money so fast
15 and hard. Laughs He just goes through it.
16 HILL: And I, I, just assume, I mean him and TOSKA
17 got that
18 worked out because man, he goes through some money.
19 And I, I'm not even going to get caught up in, in uh
20 how he does that but man. He goes through some money.
21 FARRINGTON: Hmm hmm.
22 HILL: And I, I, just, as long as he takes care of
23 his
24 business though, I ain't going to worry about it. But
25

1 the other thing about him is that what does is drives
2 him.

3 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm, to, to get some things going.

4 HILL: It, it drives him. And he's able. One of the
5 things I like about him, another thing I like about
6 him is, he is able to uh multi-task pretty well. He,
7 he
8 can kind of work on four or five things at the same
9 time.

10 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm. And, and he, and he's sharp.
11 I give it to him, he's sharp. He's just got some
12 personality quirks but...

13 HILL: Hey I...

14 FARRINGTON: But everyone does.

15 HILL: He, he...

16 FARRINGTON: So, you know, everybody and not, there's
17 not one person on this planet that does not.

18 HILL: Hey the guy is the youngest child of a big
19 family.

20 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm.

21 HILL: And he's, he's fought. I mean, you know,
22 that's just the way it is.

23 FARRINGTON: Mmm hmm.

24 HILL: All right. We rolling again, we rolling

25

1 again, we rolling again. We got a, we got a, we got
2 (UI) campaign for the, roll it, roll it out. Roll it
3 out. Okay, I'm a call STEVE and...

4 FARRINGTON: He said, he said we should go to San
5 Francisco with him.

6 HILL: Huh?

7 FARRINGTON: He said, we should go to uh San
8 Francisco with him.

9 HILL: Is he going to that planning conference?

10 FARRINGTON: Yeah.

11 HILL: Oh, that's good.

12 FARRINGTON: And he says we should go with him. I
13 think he gonna have DARWIN there too. Laughs

14 HILL: Have mercy.

15 FARRINGTON: Oh, but he said, he said DON should go,
16 I
17 mean you all should go with us cause DON can go. You
18 can make him be a part of uh, the, you know that's a
19 planning conference, and, and I'm going and so he,
20 that's a city funded trip. So, he said we could
21 figure out how to take care of yours.

22 HILL: You know what, uh, it, it, it, it, it is a
23 city funded trip but I, I, just. We, we in a middle
24 of a fight. I can only go. I'm, I got to go to
25

1 Washington. I got to go to uh, to uh, uh L.A. in late
2 April. I can only be out so many days. I just can't
3 be out all the time.

4 FARRINGTON: You're not going to take me to LA
5 with you?

6 HILL: Huh?

7 FARRINGTON: You're not going to take me to Los
8 Angeles with you?

9 HILL: Uh, I don't know baby, we going to talk about
10 it.

11 Cause that's a pension board trip. I got a little bit
12 more latitude. We'll talk about it.

13 FARRINGTON: What is there to talk about?

14 HILL: Huh?

15 FARRINGTON: What is there to talk about?

16 HILL: Just something (UI), I mean let's just have a
17 discussion. We'll talk about it.

18 FARRINGTON: You know there was a time when you
19 would automatically think like that. So, I don't
20 know.

21 HILL: Oh, uh, no baby. I automatically think like
22 that now. I just end up weighing it out and seeing
23 where we are, what we're working on and what we're
24 doing and what kind of risk it's got. I, I always
25

1 think about it. I, I was thinking about you and
2 (UI) cheap tickets. I mean I always think
3 about. That's, that's never a question of whether I
4 think about it. That's never the question. And I
5 mentioned to you to look on the network for cheap
6 tickets and you still haven't done it.

7 FARRINGTON: Well, you told me not, you said even if
8 I do, you're not going to do it.

9 HILL: No I didn't, SHEILA, SHEILA, now come on. Be
10 honest. What did I say?

11 FARRINGTON: You said even if I do.

12 HILL: What did I...

13 FARRINGTON: I, I asked you. I said even. I said so
14 are you telling me even if I do. We did talk about
15 the cheap tickets but I said, even if. You said, that
16 because of the media and all that.

17 HILL: I said what?

18 FARRINGTON: You said because of the media and all
19 that. That, the, the risk factor was greater.

20 HILL: Oh.

21 FARRINGTON: I said, so I said, so what you're saying
22 is even if I do look on cheap tickets you're going to
23 say no anyway.

24 HILL: And then what did I say?

25

1 FARRINGTON: I forgot.

2 HILL: No, you didn't forget. Laughs You...

3 FARRINGTON: Yeah, but I know it wasn't a yes.

4 HILL: And it wasn't a no.

5 FARRINGTON: Whatever it was, it was, it was

6 something that didn't encourage me to look at it.

7 HILL: That's right. That's no. What it was, was we

8 would look at it. That's what exactly what it was.

9 And you know that when you said it.

10 FARRINGTON: No, no I didn't. No, I, uh sweetheart,

11 if I say it, that's what it is in my mind. Clearly, I

12 don't ever not say..

13 HILL: But it shows..

14 FARRINGTON: I mean, I'm just telling you that's what

15 is in my mind.

16 HILL: No, but that just shows that your mind was off

17 because what I said was, we would look at it. That's

18 exactly what I said.

19 FARRINGTON: Well, we'll look at it, don't mean

20 nothing.

21 HILL: It what, it don't?

22 FARRINGTON: It means. I mean give me a yes or a no.

23 Give me some kind of motivation, some kind anxious,

24 anxiousness. Okay, let's, let's look at it. Don't

25

1 tell me drop the negative bomb and, you boom. And
2 then, okay well, we'll look at it. You already
3 dropped your negative bomb. Boom.
4 Okay, we'll look at it.
5 HILL: All right.
6 FARRINGTON: That tells me that you just trying to
7 say that just to appease me. As, as, as opposed to
8 saying, we'll let's really look at it. Let's just
9 look at it and explore it. If that had been your
10 first response, I would have been. Oh, okay, let's
11 look at it. But I can look at it. I most certainly
12 can and will. I got to figure your mind out. And,
13 and I'm getting close to that. Cause you, throughout
14 our and closer to four than three, four-year history,
15 you've been, you'll always drop those negative bombs
16 now that I think about it. Boom. And then you'll
17 say, come on. And then, so I need, I need to stop
18 listening. I have learned. I have learned in some
19 instances not to listen to what you say. Because what
20 you never do what you say. The negative bombs that
21 you drop, you never follow through on the negative
22 bombs. I was thinking about that last night. I
23 thought, he, he always just boom. But he never does
24 it. He always does the opposite. Your actions are
25

1 completely a contradiction to what you, what your, the
2 words that come out of your mouth.

3 HILL: You're right baby. Well, let me, let me call.
4 Let me go to work on STEVE then.

5 FARRINGTON: What you got to work on STEVE with?

6 HILL: I got to work on STEVE in what I just got to
7 talking about in terms of getting the, the 12:00
8 conference ready and, and beginning to set up these,
9 these uh, town hall meetings.

10 FARRINGTON: Boy, that was fast. You like okay that
11 subject is dismissed. Forget it. Boom. Now let me
12 get on to something I'm more interested in.

13 HILL: No, we just, we just spent as much time on it
14 right now that we can. We got to move on to the next
15 thing. Time to move on.

16 FARRINGTON: You know what? You better get, learn
17 how to get your words right too. I'm going to jack
18 your tail up. You better glad you're not here. I
19 would have had to duke you.

20 HILL: Let I..

21 FARRINGTON: Dot your eye. I'm tired of your mouth.

22 HILL: Want to be jacked up. Don't. Please.

23 FARRINGTON: What happened to you councilman?

24 Laughs

25

1 HILL: Jacked up...

2 FARRINGTON: Just beat up. Laughs I got, I got
3 jacked up.

4 HILL: I got jacked up. I'm sorry I got jacked up.
5 I didn't mean to be jacked up, but it just happened
6 that way.

7 FARRINGTON: Well, you better get your little words
8 right or you going to get jacked up big time.

9 HILL: Jacked up. All right baby. I'll talk to you
10 a little bit later. Call me around noontime today so
11 before you go to BRIAN'S thing.

12 FARRINGTON: Well, I got, I need to come by and get
13 the camera.

14 HILL: Okay.

15 FARRINGTON: Other than that, we're...Or do you...are
16 you going to pick the camera up.

17 HILL: No, you make the point of getting the camera.
18 I've got to many things to think about today.

19 FARRINGTON: I, I don't, I've looked in your cabinet.
20 I didn't see it yesterday. I saw this other little
21 thing.
22 It didn't look like the camera that I used.

23 HILL: STEVE has the camera.

24 FARRINGTON: Oh, okay.

25

1 HILL: He knows where it is.

2 FARRINGTON: It use to be in that cabinet.

3 HILL: Well, it may be in that cabinet. Uh, but I
4 don't know. But uh STEVE knows where it is.

5 FARRINGTON: Well, I sure need to go on and get it
6 and charge it up cause it's got to be charged. I
7 think, if I recall.

8 HILL: Two-oh-nine. Oh, I'm not buying no two-oh-
9 nine gas. They crazy.

10 FARRINGTON: You might as well. On the news, you saw
11 it yourself last night. We had a little glimpse.
12 They said the gas was going up again.
