STIPULATION CONCERNING AUTHENTICITY AND IDENTIFICATION OF
DOCUMENTS

In order to expedite the presentation of evidence in this trial and to shorten the time necessary for trial, it is hereby agreed and stipulated between the defendant and the government, that no additional evidentiary foundational basis need be offered in support of the introduction in evidence of any documents provided by the government to the defendant that were obtained during this investigation.


The parties hereby stipulate and agree that they will not contest the authenticity and identification of any document or photograph produced by the government to the defendant in discovery. In other words, the parties agree not to challenge any document any party seeks to admit at trial that was received in discovery from the government for a lack of foundation.

In addition, the parties agree that the following categories of evidence shall require no further evidentiary basis for their admissibility that were produced by any party in discovery:


1. Documents and audio/video recordings of the City of Dallas;
2. Documents and audio/video recordings obtained from any governmental agency or community organization, including but not limited to, the Texas Department of Housing and Community Affairs, the Dallas Housing and Finance Corporation, the Dallas Housing Authority, and the State of Texas; and
3. Documents and other items obtained during the searches in this case.

Each party expressly preserves any objection made on grounds other than foundation and authenticity and reserves the right to object to a specific document on other grounds, such as relevancy or hearsay.
