Ra: Peace be upon you.

Sh: Hello.

Sh: No, he says, "Call me at the number you have". I don't have a number...

Ak: Yes, yes, yes, yes.

Sh: I don't know what he wants.

Ak: I have numbers, but they don't answer. I don't know why.

Sh: Uh-uh.

Ak: Uh-uh. I will try to call him today or tomorrow.

Sh: I am not really enthusiastic about traveling.

Ak: Really?

Sh: No.

Ak: What's the reason?

Sh: I feel we are not going to bring anything. I mean, I feel that, in general, the situation in Saudi Arabia, I asked Omar, he was here this *weekend*...

Ak: Yes.

Sh: Omar Yehya.

Ak: Yes, yes.

Sh: I mean, when it has to do with Palestine, they hesitate a lot because of them have *their own*...

Ak: Uh-uh.

Sh: ...*committees and organizations*...

Ak: Yes.

Sh: And they participate in the project of one hundred and one..., this thing.

Ak: Yes.

Sh: And they will tell you, "You are coming from America. What do you have to do with Palestine. We give them directly, or we give via this...."

Ak: Yes. No, the organizations we can meet with, besides the *bank*, we can talk about subjects that have nothing to do with projects.

Sh: *Yeah*.

Ak: As for the *bank*, it's because it's a *bank*. It's different.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: It's not an organization like the Coalition.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: They work with the world.

Sh: *Yeah.*

Ak: It's a little bit different. And I expect, it is good to ... I mean, to visit the *bank*. I mean, visiting the *bank* by itself is considered a big gain.

Sh: Is there any *communication, back and forth* with them or that's it?

Ak: Last time I spoke with Shams al-Din Sulayman...

Sh: Uh-uh.

Ak: He told me that this week the Director is leaving, but my expectations are that the meeting takes place on 1/7 or 2/7 or 3/7.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: I told him, "We are going to be in Jeddah on about the twenty-ninth".

Sh: Yes.

Ak: "So, we wanted to confirm these words, and we would prefer to receive something written from you".

Sh: Yes.

Ak: So he said, "God willing". Er..., so, we will see.

Sh: We will be with him on the twenty-ninth?

Ak: No, we will be in Jeddah. I think we are traveling on the twenty-seventh...

Sh: Yes.

Ak: We will arrive on the twenty-eighth. Of course, the twenty-eighth is going to be a Thursday.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: Friday is going to be off.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: I mean, what is it ...and we are supposed to start the schedule on Saturday.

Sh: We confirmed our program on what day?

Ak: On the basis that we will travel on the twenty-seventh from here.

Sh: And it's what day?

Ak: Which is a Wednesday.

Sh: Wednesday.

Ak: Which is the day after tomorrow. We arrive on Thursday evening.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: Of course, consider Friday a day off over there.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: Friday will be lost and we are coming back on Friday.

Sh: Yes.

Ak: Uh-uh. I mean, you can say from Friday to Friday.

Sh: Yes, yes.

Ak: We come back on Friday. I mean, we will spend there about *five working days* or *six working days*.

Sh: *Ok.* What time is our flight on Wednesday?

Ak: The noon flight which is takes off about 3:20. So, we should be leaving....
