Dr. al-Turabi: God's willing, we will start our agenda and, if you allow me, if I find that a topic is thorny, I will bypass it to an easier one.  
The first topic is the relationships at the leadership level. Its strongest form is the one-to-one relationship and after that comes coordination.  
Yesterday, we listened to brother Abou Ammar speaking about this point and I leave the floor open for the brothers in Hamas to speak about this issue.

Dr. Mousa: To begin with, some points must be presented or noted in order for the relationship to be founded on openness and clarity.  
For us in the Hamas Movement, the start came with the Intifada. As for joining the unified leadership, the position was connected to the outside and is reflected on the inside. We suggested during more than one meeting to establish a joint leadership in the inside.  
As for relationships in the Arab and Islamic circles, they relate to the interests of the Palestinian people and the ten organizations....
