USAID Team visits Jenin Refugee Camp

On April 24, 2002, a team from the USAID West Bank & Gaza Mission visited Jenin to assess increased humanitarian needs in the areas of housing, nutrition and municipal infrastructure following the recent violence. The visiting USAID group included Deputy Mission Director, Bill Hammink, and representative from the Health and Water Resources Offices. They met with the Jenin Governor, Zuheir Mansara, and with hospital directors, municipal engineers and staff from United Nations Refugee Works Administration (UNRWA) and United Nations Development Program(UNDP.)

Additionally, USAID, along with other international funders, supported the delivery of two humanitarian aid convoys to Jenin and Nablus, another West Bank city, on April 19th. The convoys delivered food, water and urgently needed medical supplies to Al-Razi Hospital, the Patients Friends Society Hospital and the Jenin Government Hospital adjacent to Jenin Camp. Specific items delivered included: baby formula and food; kidney dialysis medication and supplies; pharmaceuticals such as I.V. fluids and wound care kits; and canned and packaged food basics.
