The following new Local Rule was considered and adopted by the United States District Judges for the Northern District of Texas. The rule is effective as of the date of this Order. The Clerk of Court is directed to make the necessary distribution.

**Rule 13.9 EXEMPTION FROM ADMISSION TO PRACTICE,
AND FROM REQUIREMENT OF LOCAL COUNSEL, FOR
ATTORNEYS APPEARING ON BEHALF OF THE UNITED
STATES JUSTICE DEPARTMENT OR THE ATTORNEY
GENERAL FOR THE STATE OF TEXAS**

Unless the presiding judge otherwise directs, an attorney appearing on behalf of the United States Justice Department or the Attorney General for the State of Texas, and who is eligible pursuant to Rule 13.3(a) to appear in this Court, shall be exempt from the requirements of Rules 13.3(b) and 13.4, but shall otherwise be subject to all requirements applicable to attorneys who have been granted leave to appear *pro hac vice*.
